All applicants must meet every criteria listed below:

- RESIDE <u>OR</u> ATTEND A SCHOOL whose zip code begins with 111 or 113. (Example: East Elmhurst, Corona, Jackson Heights, Astoria, Woodside, Flushing, LeFrak City, Forest Hills, Oakland Gardens, Rego Park, Elmhurst, Long Island City, Middle Village, Bayside, Fresh Meadows.)
- 2. US Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- 3. African American or African descent. Male and Female Students are Eligible to Apply.
- 4. High School Seniors expecting to graduate by June 2025, who will attend a 4-year College or University in Fall 2025.
- 5. Minimum GPA: C or 2.0/4.0 scale
